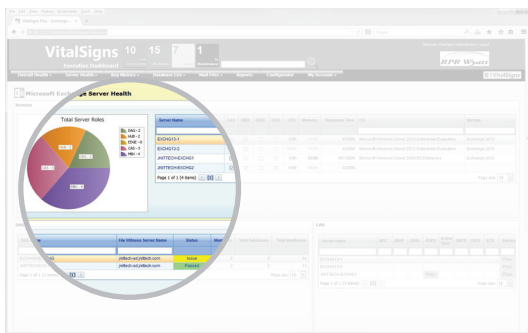
VitalSigns Exchange Monitoring Advantages
